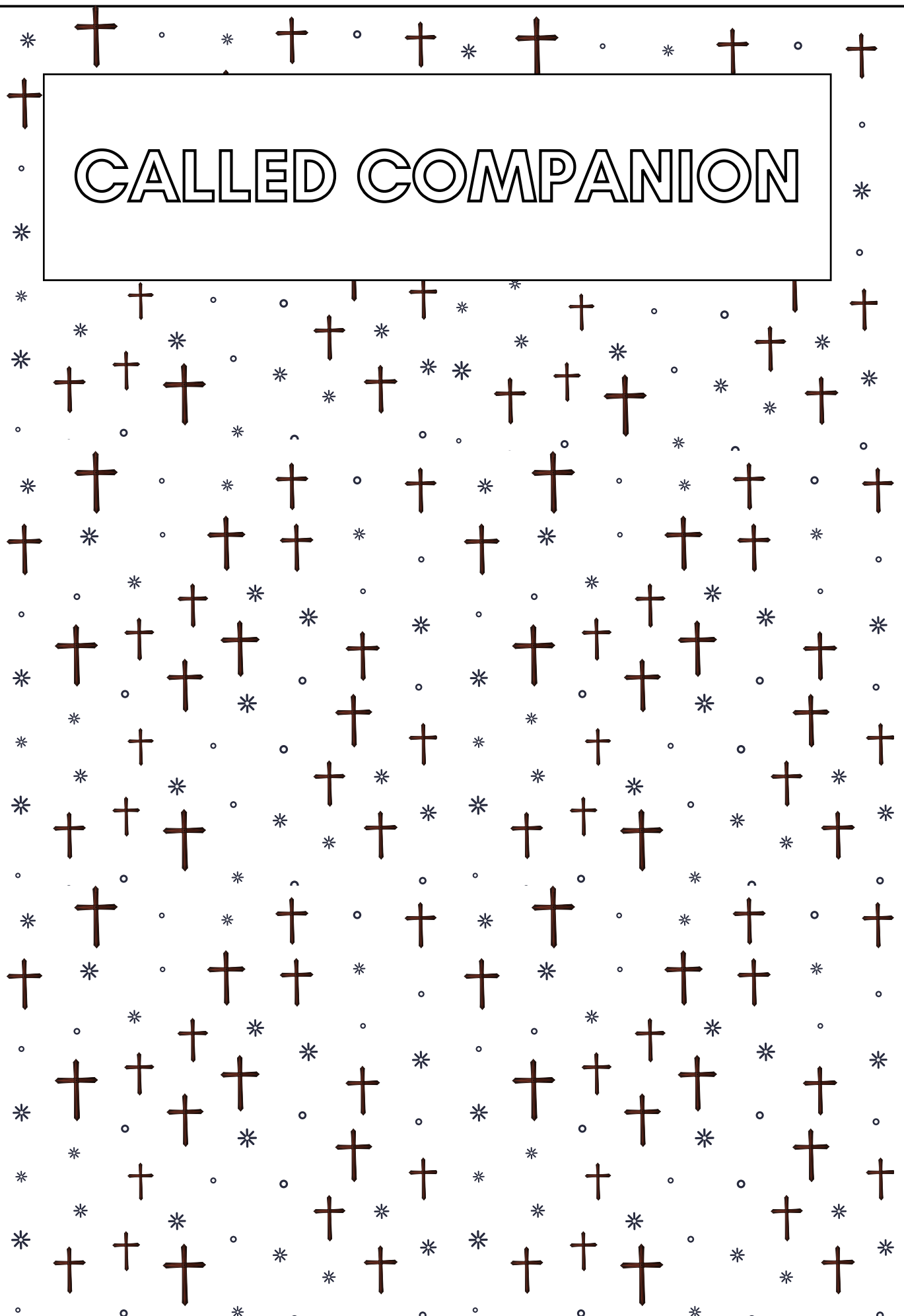
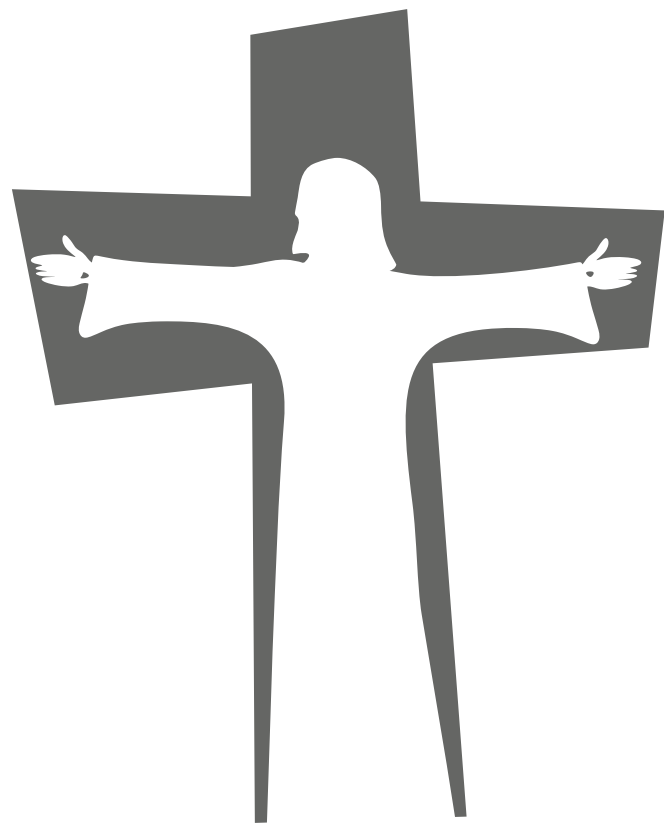


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Rabbi

Draw a picture of a meal or snack you might have that includes bread, toast, buns, pitas, or another bread product!

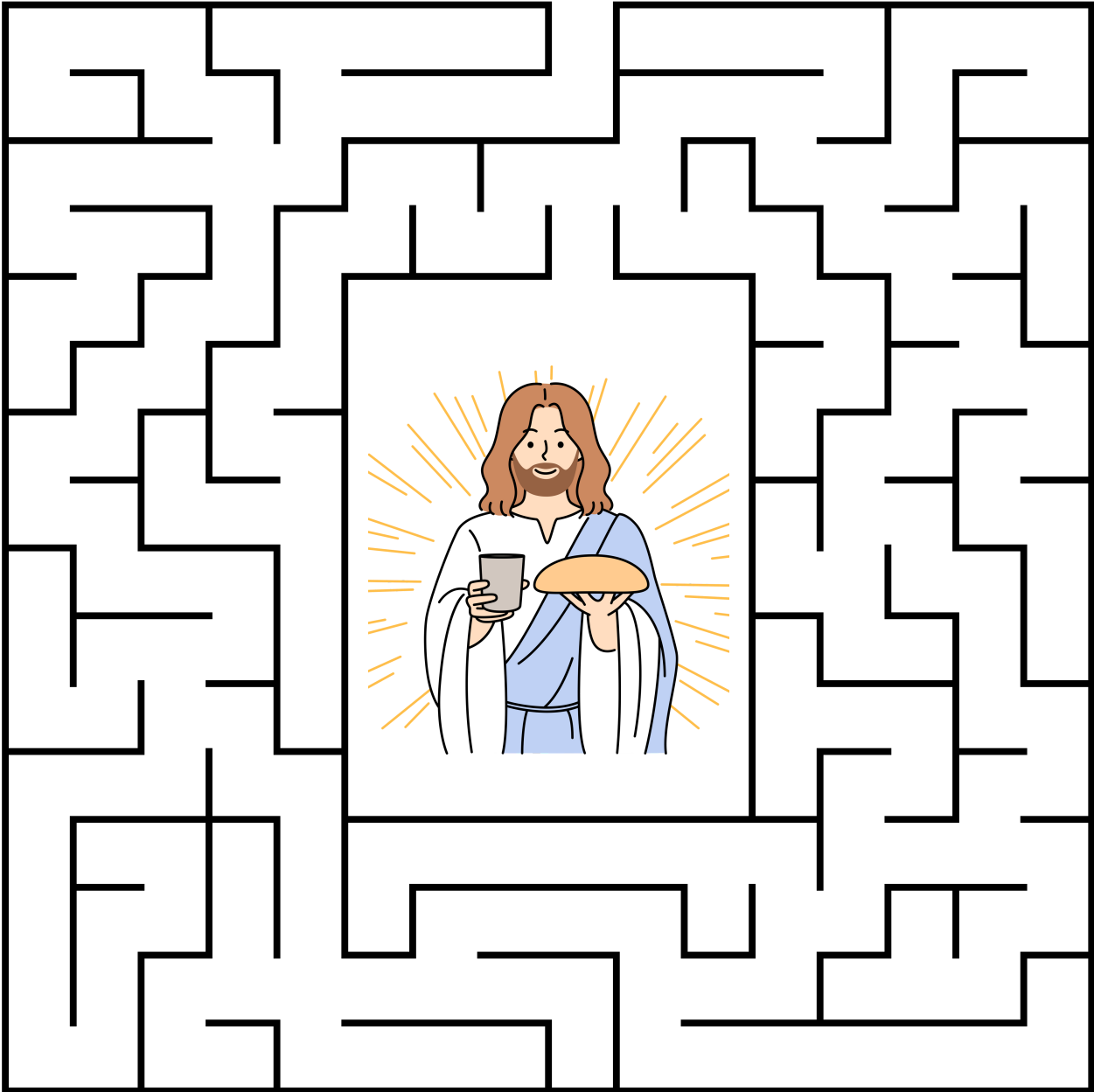


We know we eat because we get hungry and we need energy from the food to keep us going and to nourish our bodies!

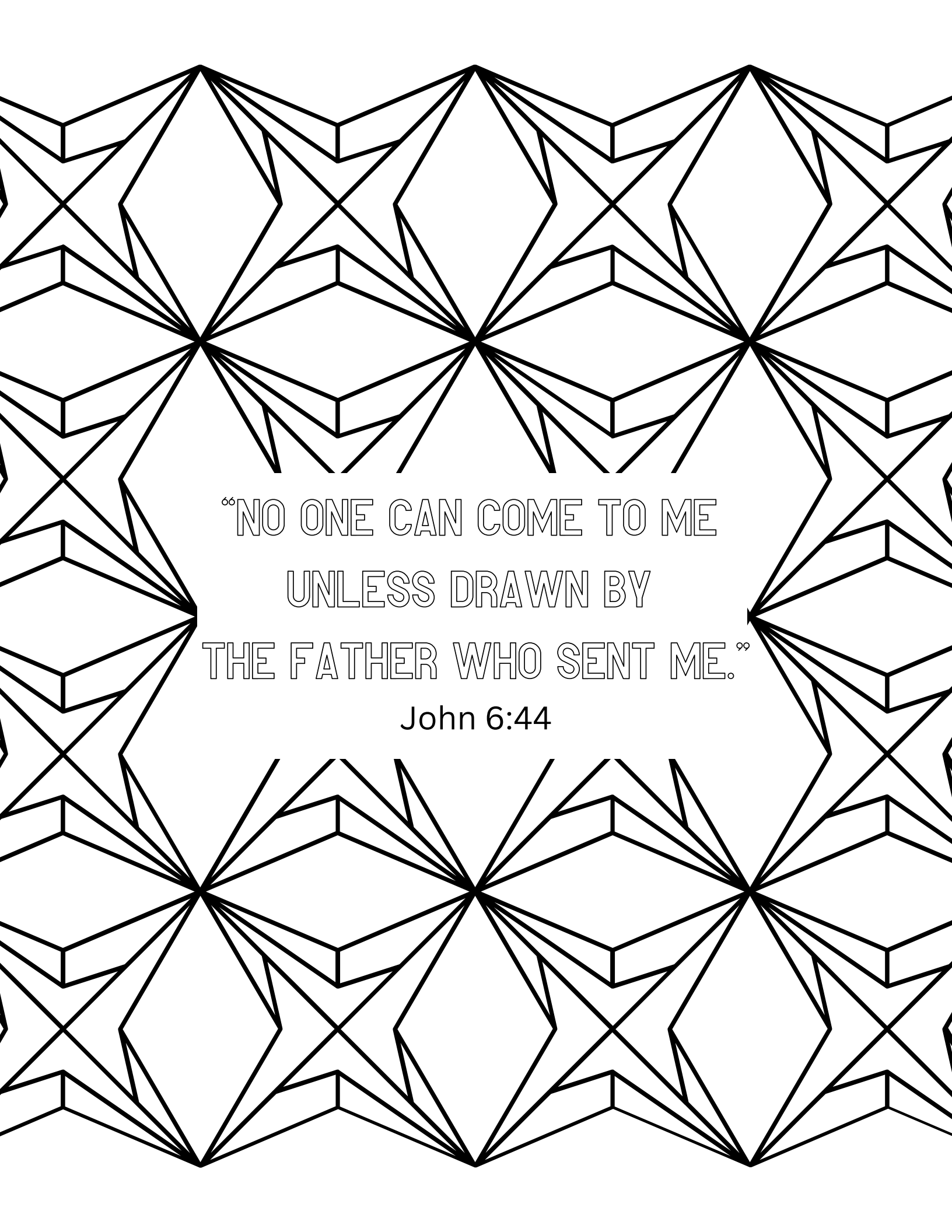

In today's Gospel we hear Jesus talking again about being the bread of life! He is talking about hunger...not in a tummy rumbling way but in a SPIRITUAL way!

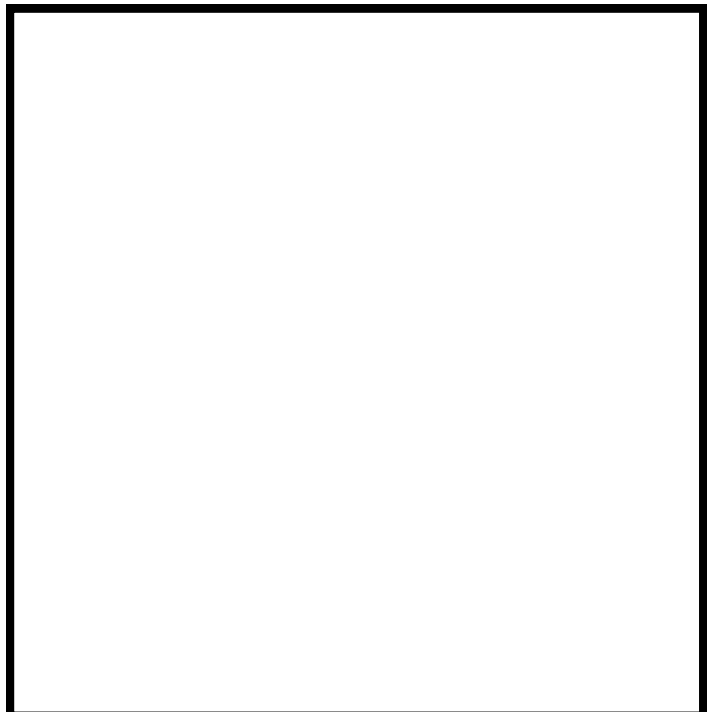
Spiritual hunger is that sad empty feeling we get that tells us we need something for our heart and soul.

Anything you can do to spend time with Jesus will allow God to fill us and take away that spiritual hunger.

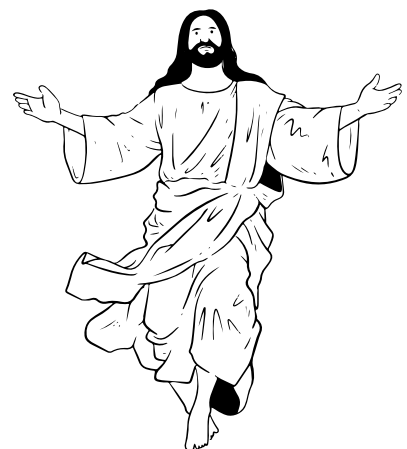
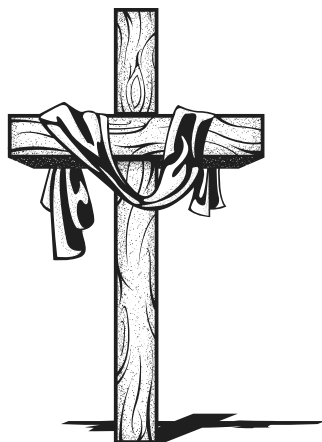
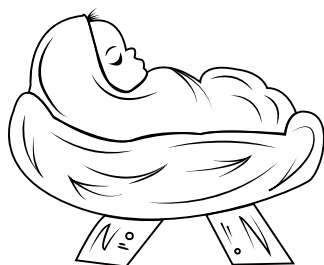
During communion we are called to remember that Jesus came to earth to teach us how to love God and how to love others.

In this week's Gospel it picks up right where last week's story left off.

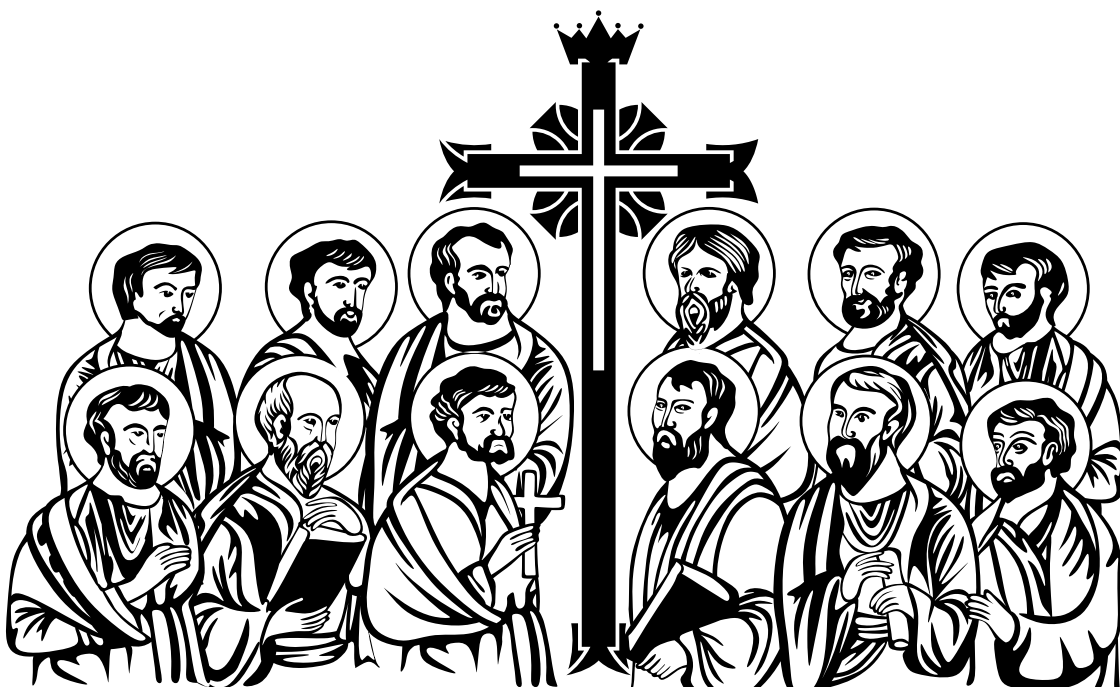
In this week's story, Jesus is still talking about being the Bread of Life.
