







Anything you can do to spend time with Jesus will allow God to fill us and take away that spiritual hunger.


During communion we are called to remember that Jesus came to earth to teach us how to love God and how to love others.




When we take the host (the bread, the eucharist) we are reminded that Jesus is the Living Bread.

In this week's Gospel it picks up right where last week's story left off.


In this week's story, Jesus is still talking about being the Bread of Life.
